Информационният бюлетин “Криминология и криминалистика” се подготвя от отдел “Правна и икономическа информация” в Националната библиотека “Св. Св Кирил и Методий” и предоставя актуална информация за престъпността, нейните прояви и борбата с нея, в различните ѝ форми.
